SECTION 5 - NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS AT THE HEALTH CENTRE

We wish to make you aware of over the counter, non-prescription medications that are given from The Health Centre and Boarding House at the Wellington Academy.

The following medications are given to students, at the discretion of the medic or boarding master on duty, as indicated by the students' condition.

Medication	Reason for administering
Soluble Paracetamol 500mg	Fever, pain relief
Paracetamol 500mg	Fever, pain relief
Ibuprofen 200mg	Fever, pain relief, anti-inflammatory
Lemsip Max	Colds/flu
Piriton	Antihistamine/allergy
Gaviscon Tablets	Indigestion
Gaviscon Liquid	Indigestion
Optrex	Conjunctivitis – eye infection
Over the counter cough mixture	Colds/Coughs
Imodium 2mg	Mild diarrhoea with no other symptoms
Dioralyte	Rehydration

The Housemaster authorizes each of the above medications to be administered without a prescription in the Academy Health Centre and in the Boarding House. Please note, on the following page, any medical reason/s that we should know about that would preclude the use of any of the above medication.

Please note that the list of medication used in the boarding house can change without notice.

PLEASE NOTE

All existing medication should arrive in the boarding house in a sealed bag, which is labelled – and left with the Housemaster. No medication is to be given directly to the child; **the Boarding House does not allow self-medication** unless agreed with the Housemaster.

In the event of a medical emergency the House Master or senior Boarding Master/Mistress on duty will act in loco parentis and authorise any emergency treatment, including a blood transfusion and surgery - if parents cannot be contacted or action needs to be taken quickly.
