

The 16 to 19 tuition fund 2021 to 2022 academic year

The school has been allocated money in order to support students who have had their previous education disrupted by the pandemic. The students eligible to receive support from the tuition fund are those who;

- have not achieved a grade 4 or 5 in English and/or maths
- have a grade 4 or above in English and/or maths, are from an economically disadvantaged background and would need catch-up support. These are defined as students from the 27% most economically deprived areas of the country based on the index of multiple deprivation

The tuition will be delivered in small groups (up to 5 students) and in some instances will be one to one. This small group support may take place in the school or may be held remotely. The support will either be provided from staff members working extra hours (for example school holidays) or be provided by external providers either during the school day or outside of regular school hours.

The Academy will prioritise tuition for those students who have not achieved a grade 4 in maths and/or English in the first instance. Students who are from an economically disadvantaged background but have achieved 4s will then be prioritised with students who have a grade 4 but have not achieved a grade 5 then receiving support.
